



BVNA Hospice Volunteer Opportunities

- Providing Administrative support to the hospice such as filing, data entry, computer work, phone calls, preparing packets and mailings, assistance with special projects, etc.
- Assisting with the Hospice Bereavement Program through co-facilitating grief support groups, assisting with the planning of hospice-sponsored memorial events, preparing bereavement mailings, and making grief support phone calls.
- Providing support to patients in their homes by providing companionship, reading the newspaper aloud, playing card or board games, facilitating life-review, preparing snacks or light meals, assisting with light housekeeping, running errands, etc.
- Providing Vet-to-Vet support to patients in their homes. This is a unique opportunity for volunteers who are veterans of any branch of the military.
- Honor veterans
- Assist with pet care for the pets of hospice patients in their homes. For hospice patients living with a terminal illness that limits their ability to care for their pets, Pet Peace of Mind volunteers assist with pet care so that pets can remain in the home with hospice patients.
- Providing support to caregivers and family members of hospice patients by providing a brief respite for the caregiver, staying alone in the home with the patient.
- Providing complimentary therapies to patients such as Music Therapy, Aromatherapy, Pet Therapy, Massage Therapy, and Reiki Therapy.
